The Mayor and Council of the City of Snellville hereby give notice of the City's intent to make available license(s) to sell distilled spirits by the package within the City Limits of Snellville. Applications are available at City Hall, 2342 Oak Road, Snellville, GA 30078 and online at snellville.org. Applications are due by **June 5, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.** and shall be submitted during business hours at City Hall to the City Manager, Assistant City Manager or City Clerk who shall document the time and date received. The City Manager will have up to 45 business days to determine if an application complies with all Ordinance requirements. A written determination will be sent by certified mail to all applicants. Should more than one applicant meet all the criteria, the Mayor and Council shall appoint an independent third party from outside the City limits to conduct a lottery to award the license. One license will be awarded in this initial process and the City may issue a second license as determined by Mayor and Council. Applicants are responsible for accurately meeting and demonstrating all the requirements in their application for license.
