XV. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Section 2-53

Each member of the public who wishes to address the Mayor and City Council in public session must submit their name, address and the topic (be as specific as possible) of their comments to the City Clerk prior to making such comments. Individuals will be allotted five minutes to make their comments and such comments must be limited to the chosen topic. Members of the public shall not make inappropriate or offensive comments at a City Council meeting and are expected to comply with our adopted rules of decorum.
- Decorum

You must conduct yourself in a professional and respectful manner. All remarks should be directed to the Chairman and not to individual Council Members, staff or citizens in attendance. Personal remarks are inappropriate.

XI. EXECUTIVE SESSION

An Executive Session may be called:

- To discuss pending and/or potential litigation, settlement claims, administrative proceedings or other judicial actions, which is exempt from the Open Meetings Act pursuant to O.C.G.A. Section 50-14-2(1).

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- To authorize negotiations to purchase, dispose of, or lease property; authorize the ordering of an appraisal related to the acquisition or disposal of real estate; enter into a contract to purchase, dispose of, or lease property subject to approval in a subsequent public vote; or enter into an option to purchase, dispose of, or lease real estate subject to approval in subsequent public vote, which is excluded from the Open Meetings Act pursuant to Section 50-14-3(b)(1)(C).
- Upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee, which is excluded pursuant to O.C.G.A. Section 50-14-3(b)(2).
